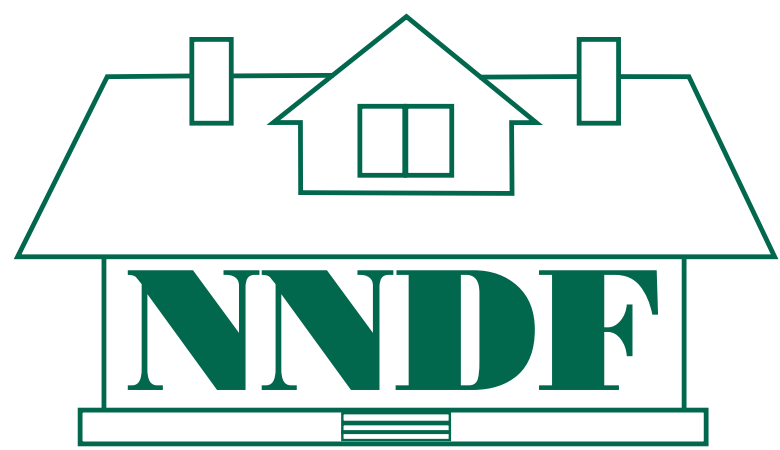

- From incompatible development that undermines the character and stability of our neighborhoods,
- From pro-development officials who ignore resident concerns, and
- From pro-development special interest groups that influence the zoning process.

How can neighborhoods respond to these challenges?

By joining together with other neighborhood residents to impact the political and legal processes which affect our neighborhoods with land use decisions.

By law, most neighborhood associations cannot engage in political activity. They cannot endorse candidates. Most neighborhoods do not have the financial resources necessary to mount a legal challenge to defend themselves.

What is the Nashville Neighborhood Defense Fund?

The NNDF is a political action committee whose goal is to protect neighborhoods.

How does the NNDF work?

Neighborhood residents join together by pooling their funds to increase their impact on the political process.

It's simply a matter of numbers.

What does the NNDF do with the funds raised?

- Recruits and supports pro-neighborhood candidates for local and state offices, such as the Metro Council, Mayor, and the state legislature.
- Engages in issue advocacy at the local and state level.
- Provides legal representation to neighborhoods.
- And other activities that strengthen and protect neighborhoods.

How is the NNDF organized?

The NNDF is organized around neighborhoods, but is not affiliated with any neighborhood associations or organizations.

The NNDF has a separate governing Board and an Advisory Committee of representatives from each of the neighborhoods contributing to the Fund.

As a NNDF member, you will be asked to vote on policy and candidate recommendations to the Board.

How can I become involved?

By contributing monthly to the NNDF.
